CEZD ASF Weekly Intelligence Report: February 16-22, 2019

Disease/Pathogen Information

- Vietnam <u>has reported</u> being affected by ASF this week with outbreaks in three villages totalling 257 animals.
- Disease continues to spread in Europe and China
 - Europe the pattern of spread within Europe remains the same. Wild boar 'outbreaks' are usually only an individual animal or a small group.
 - Wild boar Belgium, Bulgaria, Hungary, Latvia, Poland, Romania, Ukraine
 - Domestic swine Romania
 - China several outbreaks, including two new provinces: Shandong (eastern) and Guangxi (southern China, bordering Vietnam).
- U. S. Customs and Border Protection at the Port of New York/Newark <u>intercepted</u> twenty-three shipments, which contained over 10,000 kilograms of prohibited animal products from China, attempting to make entry into the United States via containerized sea cargo.

Control Measures Information

 Pig Progress <u>reports</u> that Belgium will expand the inner zone of control as the total count of wild boar infected with ASF virus has grown to 522. On the French side of the border, the wild boar cull continues as well as fence construction.
